

MINUTES OF THE WAYNESBURG VILLAGE COUNCIL  
JUNE 10, 2019

Waynesburg Village Council met in regular session with Mayor Welch and five members present: Knight, Davis, Anthony, Dierick, and Dennis.

The meeting was called to order and the minutes of the May 23, 2019 meeting were read and stand approved as read.

A motion was made to excuse McCray by Anthony and seconded by Knight. VOTE: ANTHONY YEA, KNIGHT YEA, DENNIS YEA, DIERICK YEA, AND DAVIS YEA. Motion carried.

Molly Murphy: Mike came to see whose responsibility it was for the drain, didn't want to fill it in and be wrong. I do work for Pike Township, and talk with the county often. Let me say feels if you're not used to coming to meetings this setting is intimidating with you setting up there and looking down. Printed map – who ever said was wrong to mistaken they often are. Feel that is was wrong how Mike was spoken to calling him a liar. You was not very professional, I am the one who printed the map. You said you were going to send someone to check if water goes thru and would notify Mike when this was going to be done, no one did. Who ever spoke with him on the phone was rude. Molly going to fill in drain. Scott said you have to give respect to get respect. Scott our point of view if we help someone on private property then we would have to do for all. Molly resident pay for the material and then the township would repair when there was a drainage issue. Explained we hire out as we don't have the equipment to do our own repairs.

David: received a quote for drainage on Taft St at a cost of \$4,850.00 and quote for Hillside and Maple St to replace three drains at cost of \$5,800.00. Need to order patching. Vinton would like to come in this week weather permitting to start prep work on Wilson St.

A motion was made to hire Ayers to fix drains Hillside and Taft St not to exceed 12,500.00 by Anthony and seconded by Dierick. VOTE: ANTHONY YEA, DIERICK YEA, DENNIS YEA, KNIGHT YEA, DAVIS ABSTAIN, Motion carried.

A motion was made to get patching to repair holes by Dierick and seconded by Anthony. VOTE: DIERICK YEA, ANTHONY YEA, DAVIS YEA, KNIGHT YEA, AND DENNIS YEA. Motion carried.

Chief Bath: presented the monthly report for May 2019. Patrolwoman Alberta has been deployed to Afghanistan-National Guards. Received donated money from church used to get shirts and supplies for the department, need to purchase two shirts for the new patrolman.

A motion was made to purchase two shirts from Akron Uniforms by Anthony and seconded by Knight. VOTE: ANTHONY YEA, KNIGHT YEA, DENNIS YEA, DIERICK YEA, AND DAVIS YEA. Motion carried.

Scott: is getting nice out, how are we going to handle curfew? Chief Bath curfew is 10:00 pm unless 18 or accompanied by a parent or guardian, not 18 year old sibling with 17 year old sibling. Scott feels is a different situation if just walking back alleys than a group of people playing basketball. Chief was asked if an officer shut the lights off on a group plying basketball, stated no. Scott all for enforcing curfew though out village, but when playing basketball can let play.

Scott: dispatching you was opposed looking into other dispatching. With Stark County savings of \$320.00 a month. Chief they have always been two to three times that amount. Jeremy asks if could get a signed contract for two or three years. Chief is could save \$3,000.00 or more a year would be for that, but never have been.

Scott: 59 fire calls, about six personnel per call. Still in running for grants (air packs and compressor, and tanker-engine). Agrees to buy new hose and tires for trucks, maintenance.

Mayors' court for May 2019 receipted \$3,390.00 with the State receiving \$520.00 and the General Fund \$2,870.00.

Presented: financials, bank statements for May 2019. Consumers National points awarded for May 2019 are 512 for a total of 10,538.

Letter was sent to Steve (gravedigger) looks like he came and took care of graves.

Solicitor Anthony: road and bridge levy did pass. General fund can be up to three attempts for renewal. Need a resolution for certificate of estimated property tax revenue.

A motion was made to suspend the rules on a Resolution Requesting Stark County Auditor to Certify To The Village Of Waynesburg Of Stark County, Ohio ("Village") An Estimate Of Property Tax Revenue by Anthony and seconded by Dierick. VOTE: ANTHONY YEA, DIERICK YEA, DENNIS YEA, KNIGHT YEA, DAVIS YEA. Motion carried.

A motion was made to adopt resolution 6-435-19 Resolution Requesting Stark County Auditor to Certify To The Village Of Waynesburg Of Stark County, Ohio ("Village") An Estimate Of Property Tax Revenue by Anthony and seconded by Knight. VOTE: ANTHONY YEA, KNIGHT YEA, DENNIS YEA, DIERICK YEA, AND DAVIS YEA. Motion carried.

Mayor Welch: have several properties that need mowing letters. Jeremy: laundromat has rotted boat and weeds. Have sprayed Cibos to N Main etc. Asked if council is still willing to help mulch trees. Building on corner of S Main and W Silver St, has broken windows and is deteriorating.

Mayor Welch; received a quote from Wisenburg for apron and curbing by Village Hall, sidewalks, curb approach and flag pole base \$7,600.00.

Jeremy: trees are dead along curb; Custom Landscape price would be Two Hundred each for tree and replacing. Approximately 10 trees, \$75.00 per tree and \$125.00 per tree to install.

A motion was made for Custom Landscape to replace dead trees on state route up to 10 trees at a cost of \$200.00 by Anthony and seconded by Dierick. VOTE: ANTHONY YEA, DIERICK YEA, DENNIS YEA, KNIGHT YEA, AND DAVIS YEA. Motion carried.

Jeremy asked about the old ball park, fire department is going to take care of.

Mayor: there will be a zoning meeting on April 13, 2019 at 6:30 pm.

Scott: park board working on a plan for the ball field, pretty much done for grant, sent in with needed attachments. Working on quotes for fields and pavilion excavating equipment. Receive a \$196,000.00 for grant can apply for early release of \$65,000.00 towards project. Can't use money for maintenance or maintenance vehicles.

Jeff: asked if can part out, split up in different tiers to different vendors.

Discussed funding of project, bidding or not bidding. If think going to be \$50,000.00 or close to should be competitive bid. Seek quotes for jobs if want to get the best.

A motion was made to pay the bills totaling \$29,049.48 by Dierick and seconded by Anthony. VOTE: DIERICK YEA, ANTHONY YEA, DAVIS YEA, KNIGHT YEA, AND DENNIS YEA. Motion carried.

A motion was made to adjourn the meeting by Dierick and seconded by Anthony. VOTE: DIERICK YEA, ANTHONY YEA, DAVIS YEA, KNIGHT YEA, AND DENNIS YEA. Motion carried.
