

MINUTES OF THE WAYNESBURG VILLAGE COUNCIL
SPECIAL MEETING
DECEMBER 29, 2018

Waynesburg Village Council and Board of Public Affairs met in a special session for discussing possible hire of personnel at 7:00 am.

Those present: Mayor Welch, Knight, McCray, Davis, Anthony, Dierick, Solicitor Anthony, Mizer and Alberty.

Mayor came to meet about Paul.

Scott: had two full time employees always paying in winter and no work, feel now Kyle is gone is time to correct.

Jeff: water offered to pay half the wages worry about if John doesn't come back feels should hire Paul as David is not able to do it all.

Scott: feel not to hire for winter, not enough work.

Ladd: David should not be on own when working on equipment.

Rick: Safety is number one.

Ladd: if you don't hire Paul he will work in water only.

Scott: if that's what needs done then maybe hire a second guy for street, graves etc. The concern is the winter months.

Ladd: for sixteen years always had two guys.

Jeremy: when Kyle was here he worked and practically done the cemetery on his own plus everything else. Solution-water 30- David full time water and split cost of insurance. Street hire Paul for 16 to 20 hours winter, if need more could come in street 100%. Summer 32 hours split between street and cemetery to help Paul.

Jeremy: suggest that David read the meters.

Ladd disagrees has always been separate.

Jeremy: don't understand why not.

Jeff: understand were coming from very minimal wages.

Jeremy: waste of money winter hours.

Scott: asked if possible less meter read.

Paul 16 to 20 hour winter – summer 32 hours.

Jeff: all together lets talk about this, Jeremy all work together don't care where all work at – work were needed.

Jeremy: council and water make dollars work, and no changes how work. I went to the water and asked why John was mowing at the cemetery.

Jeff: in spring will voice about how done.

Paul: 16 to 20 hours winter if no work to go home – 32 hours summer. Need another person.

Jeremy and Scott; have someone in mind for summer,

Scott: will take pride in job

Jeff: water said if doesn't share in wage wont share guy.

Rick: hired by the Village – you work for the Village – doesn't matter where you are paid from just get the work done. There is always something to do.

If not needed then go home. But David won't do that.

Jeremy: opinion is not be in the cemetery unless drastically needed.

Dave: retain Paul, restructure pay and I agree with rick work together.

Solicitor: have to pay accordingly by fund.

Jeff: suggest keeping Paul thru the winter, so still have in summer.

Discuss pay structures.

A motion was made to hire Paul for up to 20 hours a week by Davis and seconded by Anthony. Discussion: Rick will discuss with David and make it understood that if not needed to send him home motion modified to up to 30 hours a week as modified by Scott. VOTE: DAVIS YEA, ANTHONY YEA, DIERICK YEA, KNIGHT YEA, AND MCCRAY YEA. Motion carried.

A motion was made to adjourn the meeting by Davis and seconded by McCray. VOTE: DAVIS YEA, MCCRAY YEA, KNIGHT YEA, DIERICK YEA, AND ANTHONY YEA. Motion carried.
